2014 has been a successful shooting season for IPSC New Brunswick. Membership in IPSC New Brunswick is at approximately 100 members, and numerous competitions were held across the province. Most of the competitions are designated as club level, Level I and Level II, and 2014 is the first year in recent memory that three Level III matches were held in the province in the same year. The first Level III was held in June in Hampton and drew 44 competitors, the second held in Dalhousie drew 139 competitors, and the third was the Provincial Championship in Hampton with 37 competitors.

Three members attended the IPSC National Championships in British Columbia in August and two competed at the IPSC World Championships in Florida in October.

With respect to training, two Chief Range Officer courses were held in the spring, resulting in 8 new Chief Range Officer designations for provincial members.

The finances for IPSC New Brunswick remain strong as shown on the attached Financial Statements.
