RNBRA Executive Meeting Minutes

January 30, 2023

- 1. <u>Call to Order & Opening Remarks</u>: The meeting was called to order at 7:04pm.
- 2. <u>Reading of Article 10.02 of the By-Laws</u>: Article 10.02 was read by Laura.
- 3. <u>Agenda Approval</u>: Gord requested to add Correspondence to the Agenda. Laura motioned to approve the agenda as amended. Motion was seconded and CARRIED.
- 4. <u>Correspondence</u>: Gord recently had a phone call with the Chief Firearms Officer. One item discussed was the RNBRA submitting an application to become a club recognized by the CFO; Gord has received the application and would like the Board to discuss this. Gord noted that a club must be affiliated with a gun range. Steven noted that the RNBRA could set up a separate entity that is affiliated with a range to meet the application requirements.

The other item discussed was the RNBRA being involved with the upcoming range review committee. Gord has been invited to join the committee representing the RNBRA.

5. <u>Core Funding Disbursement</u>: Clubs and sections submitted their funding requests and a discussion was held on how to disburse the Sport and Recreation Core Funding of \$22,200. The following distribution was motioned by Steven to be presented to the Board for their approval. Motion was seconded and CARRIED.
